



1. This view of Hurst Green looking towards Chapel Road shows how buildings of different ages and styles give effective enclosure to the Green because they share so many common characteristics.



2. These properties in Mill Street are of some historic interest although various alterations and the loss of front garden boundaries to car parking have taken their toll.



3. The former Wesleyan Methodist School in Chapel Road has found a new use. The loss of the front boundary wall is a disappointment, however, which affects the character of this part of the Area.



4. These properties east of John Street in the wider part of the High Street show considerable evidence of reworking over the years. Apart from one or two regrettable features, they are an important part of the specific character of this intermediate part of the High Street as it runs into Hurst Green.
