



New & Improved Play Facilities

In 2008 Tendring District Council scooped over £288,000 in Big Lottery funding to provide new and refurbished play facilities across Tendring. The funding was allocated to five projects across the district, some of which have now been completed, or are due to be completed during 2010.

DETAILS OF THE FIVE PROJECTS FUNDED BY THE BIG LOTTERY FUND:

Project Name/Location: New Play Area, Mace Park, Dovercourt

Project Details: To remove the old play equipment and install a new, modern and fenced play area aimed at children under the age of 12 years.

Expected Completion Date: Completed

Project Name/Location: New Play Area, Lady Nelson Playing Field, Thorpe-le-Soken

Project Details: To install new play equipment aimed at children under the age of 12 years. The new play area will provide greater play opportunity to young people in the village.

Expected Completion Date: Early 2010

Project Name/Location: Multi-use Games Area, Park Playing Fields, Frinton

Project Details: This project will provide much needed teenage play provision at Park Playing Fields, Frinton. The project consists of the construction of a multi-use games area as well as a youth shelter.

Expected Completion Date: Early 2010

Project Name/Location: Interactive Play Route, Harwich & Dovercourt

Project Details: The interactive Play Route will link a number of existing play areas in the Harwich and Dovercourt area as well as providing new and exciting play equipment at a number of locations along the route. The Play Route will run from Harwich Green, Harwich via Cliff Park, Dovercourt to Dovercourt Swimming Pool and Low Road Recreation Ground, Dovercourt.

Expected Completion Date: Late 2010

Project Name/Location: Multi-use Games Area, Tokley Road, Frating

Project Details: The aim of this project is to purchase one hectare of land in the parish of Frating. Once purchased a multi-use games area will be constructed and the site will be fenced and landscaped. However, due to the lack of land available in Frating finding land is proving difficult, therefore this project is being review regularly.
