



13. This view of Nelson Street looking north shows how relatively simple houses are given additional grandeur by their symmetrical treatment, with paired doorcases. The nearer properties demonstrate how attractive this part of the Area might be given the restoration of original finishes and details.



14. The central part of New Street, looking south. What seems to be a townscape of average interest turns on closer inspection to have a fascinating plan form, though as is evident here, there are many alterations to the houses on either side.



15. Houses of the special Brightlingsea type stand here in Sydney Street with side gardens or yards which probably represent undeveloped plots. The side elevations to the frontage treatment to the street become of extreme importance.



16. Two houses, made grander by positioning one front door on a side return. It is unfortunate that the property with the beautiful door case also has plastic windows in openings of altered proportions.
