Manningtree Sports Centre and Frinton & Walton Swimming Pool:

Information provided from Air Conditioning Services (ACS) the company who service the units at Manningtree Sports Centre and Frinton & Walton Swimming Pool and the operating manual. Manningtree Sports Centre - two units each 6kw total output for the room 12kw FWSP - one unit with an output of 8kw. The requirement is to have a TM44 certificate "where the effective rated output is more than 12kW", this is confirmed by the corporate H&S Officer. Following this criteria neither Manningtree Sports Centre nor Frinton & Walton Swimming Pool need certifying.

Harwich Sports Centre & Dovercourt Pool:

This is a nil response from Harwich Sports Centre as it has no air con and in case of Dovercourt Pool air con does not exceed 12kw, therefore answer to q's is n/a.
