29/07/2014	8 customers bank details compromised due to inadvertent duplex printing error.	Breach	£ -
10/09/2014	Theft of council owned Blackberry device along with other personally owned items from employee's home address. Zero personal data loss as device immediately blocked and wiped.	Incident	£ -
