Getting Nuisance Calls ? then register with the Telephone Preference Service

The best way to stop nuisance calls is to register your number with the Telephone Preference Service. They will add you to their list of numbers that do not want to receive sales & marketing calls.

You can call them to register on 0345 070 0707 or you can discuss your problem with the helpline on 0845 703 4599.

It is a free service and easy to register. You will need your phone number, postcode and an email address to sign up on the Telephone Preference Service website. You can also sign up from your mobile, by texting 'TPS', and your email address, to 85095

It is illegal for a company to call numbers registered with the Telephone Preference Service.

Easy to Make Scrumptious Raspberry Cake - **Caution contains nuts !**

Ingredients :-

- 5 oz Self Raising Flour
- 5 oz Caster Sugar
- 5 oz Soft Butter or Margarine
- 5 oz Ground Almonds
- 1 tsp Ground Cinnamon
- 1 Egg
- $\frac{1}{2}$ lb Raspberries



Instructions :- Oven Temp 160 C

Mix all the ingredients, (apart from fruit), in a processor. Spread half the mixture into a greased loose bottomed 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " tin. Sprinkle fruit on top, then spread rest of mixture over the raspberries (does not matter if there are gaps). Flaked almonds topping optional.

Cook for 40 mins (watch from 35 mins). Leave to cool, then sprinkle with icing sugar.

Staff Identity - Bogus Callers
