Essex County Council Election of ONE Councillor for the Clacton East Electoral Division

1. Nomination papers may be obtained from the Deputy Returning Officer, Town Hall, Station Road, Clacton-on-Sea, Essex, CO15 1SE during office opening hours (8:45am to 5:15pm Mondays to Thursdays and 8:45am to 4:45pm on Fridays).
2. Completed nomination papers must be delivered by hand to the Deputy Returning Officer, Town Hall, Station Road, Clacton-on-Sea, Essex, CO15 1SE, during the times stated above from the date of this notice but not later than 4:00pm on Thursday 5 September 2019.
3. If any election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday, 3rd October 2019, between the hours of 7:00am to 10:00pm.
4. The last day to submit an application to be included in the Electoral Register to be used at this election is Tuesday 17 September 2019. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote> .
5. Applications for, amendments to or cancellations of arrangements to vote by post or by proxy must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Town Hall, Station Road, Clacton-on-Sea, Essex, CO15 1SE by 5:00pm on Wednesday, 18th September 2019, if they are to be effective for this election.
6. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Town Hall, Station Road, Clacton-on-Sea, Essex, CO15 1SE by 5:00pm on Wednesday, 25th September 2019.
7. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Town Hall, Station Road, Clacton-on-Sea, Essex, CO15 1SE by 5:00pm on Thursday, 3rd October 2019.
