

## **FOI 283/2015**

### **REQUEST**

I wish to make a freedom on Information request for the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000

1.) The CCTV recordings for the 16 June 2015 between 7pm to 9pm

For the the CCTV that records from the top of marine parade east clacton on sea , that records the mini golf course and the walk slop that go past Armstrongs's pub to the sea front

### **RESPONSE**

Unfortunately, we are not able to provide the CCTV footage requested.

We are applying the following exemption to this FOI request:

***Section 31(1) states that Information which is not exempt information by virtue of section 30 is exempt information if its disclosure under this Act would, or would be likely to, prejudice —***

- (a) the prevention or detection of crime;***
- (b) the apprehension or prosecution of offenders or***
- (c) the administration of justice***

We are applying this exemption as if the Council releases the details you are requesting this could prejudice the prevention or detection of crime and the apprehension or prosecution of offenders.

The Authority has applied the public interest test and determined that in all the circumstances of the case, the public interest in maintaining the exemption outweighs the public interest in disclosing the information.

***We are only required to release CCTV footage if one of the following applies:***

- (a) An official requisition order from Essex Police***
- (b) An official order from an insurance company and the appropriate fee paid***
- (c) An official order from a lawyer/solicitor and the appropriate fee paid.***

(Please note that CCTV footage is automatically overwritten after 30 days).
