- 4. Did your council complete a privacy impact assessment before trialling or implementing body worn cameras? No Police advice sought CEOs only turn on camera if faced with a confrontational situation. Council is currently drafting guidelines on use.

- 5. Please provide the make, model and manufacturer of the body worn cameras you have purchased. Pinnacle PR5
- 6. Where and for how long is the footage held? On secure council system only retained if there is an incident and then only if Police want footage otherwise deleted.
- 7. Please provide documentation relating to the results of any trial of body worn cameras that your force has undertaken. No such data.
