**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2020
FOOTPATH 11 ST OSYTH**

On 13 May 2020 Essex County Council confirmed the above order made under section 118 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to extinguish part widths of part of the length of Footpath 11 St Osyth of variable width shown by a bold continuous line on the Order Map commencing from the junction with the publicly maintainable highway known as New House Farm Road running in a generally south easterly then south south easterly direction along land encompassing a vehicular driveway and garden area around a pond for a total distance of approximately 81 metres to point close to the south east corner of the pond.

Documents can be made available for inspection 8.30am-5.30pm Mon-Thurs and 8.30am-5pm on Friday at Essex County Council, County Hall, E block main reception, Market Road, Chelmsford if so required following the current social distancing restrictions. The order came into force on 27 May 2020, but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 28 May 2020 make an application to the High Court.
