	Substance location plan	<p>A plan of the land to which the application relates, drawn to a scale of not less than 1:2,500, which identifies-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) any area of land intended to be used for the storage of the substance;</li> <li>(b) where the substance is to be used in a manufacturing, treatment or other industrial process, the location of the major items of plant involved in that process in which the substance will be present; and</li> <li>(c) access points to and from the land.</li> </ul>
