

Tendring District Council (TDC) and Colchester City Council (CCC) Notice of Submission of the Tendring Colchester Borders Graden Community Development Plan Document

Notice is given in accordance with the above Regulations that TDC and CCC submitted the Tendring Colchester Borders Graden Community Development Plan Document (DPD) to the Secretary of State on 21st September for independent examination.

Subject Matter: The DPD sets out the Councils planning framework for future development of a new Garden Community proposed for land crossing the Tendring and Colchester border.

Area Covered: Land east of Colchester, to the south of the A120 covering an area of approx. 715ha.
